



## **SCHEDULE OF TRAININGS FOR ADA PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2022/2023**

The National Authority for the Campaign against Alcohol and Drug Abuse (NACADA) was established through an Act of Parliament in 2012 and mandated to coordinate a multi-sectoral campaign aimed at preventing, controlling and mitigating the impact of alcohol and drug abuse in Kenya.

The overall goal of ADA prevention and management training is to reduce the health, social and economic problems associated with substance use by building prevention capacity on the most effective evidence-based preventive interventions and strategies.

NACADA will therefore utilize two modes of training in FY 2022-23 as follows:

1. Online trainings
2. In house trainings

Brief explanation on trainings:

<b>Online training</b>
Online training is currently available for ADA committees and student welfare staff. The training is a combination of live online sessions and self-paced learning over a period of 3 weeks. Guidelines are available on the website. Training is scheduled once quorum is attained.
<b>In house training</b>
In house training- this means an individual institution organizes for the training and caters for the cost (conference, own staff and NACADA facilitation & subsistence allowances). This applies to ADA committees, Student Welfare staff, Managers and Supervisors, and Peer educators. There should be a minimum of 10 participants to qualify for in house training.
